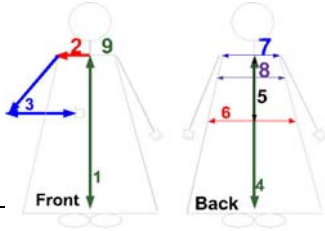

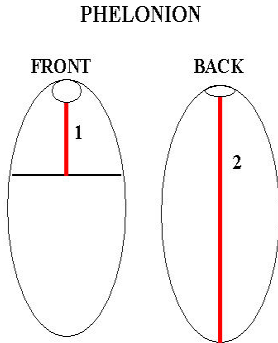

Chart Coordinates	Description	Measurements
	Measure over clothing for garments that are worn over clothing. For Best results, have someone help you take your measurements. Custom orders are not returnable, we are not responsible for measurements which are not correct.	Write your measurement in inches.
2	Length of shoulder seam. Measure from the side of the neck to where the shoulder meets the arm (you can expect this measure to be somewhere between 6 and 8 inches depending on your size).	
3	Regular Sleeve Length. With the arm slightly bent in front of you like holding a candle – measure from where the shoulder meets the arm - continuing around the outside of the elbow - then, continuing to the wrist	
2 + 3 + distance to center of neck	Length of Arm: With the arm slightly bent in front of you like holding a candle, measure from the center of the back of the neck (where neck is level with the shoulders at the top of the spine) - continuing to where the shoulder meets the arm - then, continuing around the outside of the elbow - then, continuing to the wrist	
3	If an outer cassock is ordered and you want the sleeves to extend beyond the finger tips when the arms are at your side, measure from the center of the back of the neck (where the neck is level with the shoulders at the top of the spine) - continuing to where the shoulder meets the arm - then continuing to the end of the finger tips with your arms at your side	
9	Neck Size. If you wear a clergy shirt or a cassock under your vestments, please be sure to measure around that collar while you are wearing it. Measure over any collar you normally wear under your cassock or vestments and around the part of the collar that is most full.	
1	Bottom of collar to bottom of garment, Front. This would be where you would like the length of the Vestment to fall in the front – for example, the ankle at the top of the shoe. Wear shoes you would normally wear to take this measurement.	
6	Waist. To find waist, bend to the side – the crease is where the waist is, measure around that location	
4	Bottom of collar to bottom of garment, Back. This would be where you would like the length of the Vestment to fall in the back – for example, the ankle at the top of the shoe. Wear shoes you would normally wear to take the measurement	
5	Waist Drop: From the back of the collar, measure from the bottom of the collar to Waist	
7	Shoulder Width: Measure from shoulder tip to shoulder tip	
8	Chest. Measure under the arms at the most full part of the Chest

Shirt Size	Please give Dress Shirt Size. Example: 17 33/34	
Suit Coat Size	Please give Suit Coat Size. Example: 42 Regular

Additional Measurement information for a Phelonion if a set of Priest Vestments are ordered:



Phelonion Front Length (#1 on the image to the left). The front of Greek Style Phelonions are typically up to 24 inches long from the front collar and will be made this length unless you specify otherwise. If you require a shorter or longer Phelonion front, please measure to where you would like the front of the Phelonion to end from the bottom of the front collar. **You only need to fill in this section if you require a different length in the front.**

#1. Phelonion Front. Length of drop at the front of the Phelonion from the bottom of the front collar _____

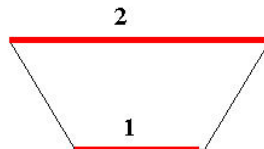
Phelonion Back Length (#2 on the image to the left). The back of Greek Style Phelonions are long. They are typically a little shorter than the Sticharion (Undergarment) and will be made this way unless you specify otherwise. If you require a shorter length in the back, please measure where you would like the back of the Phelonion to end from the bottom of the back collar. **You only need to fill in this section if you require a shorter length in the back.**

#2. Phelonion Back. Length of drop at the back of the Phelonion from the bottom of the back collar _____

*Please note: By tradition, Greek Style Phelonions are **not** fastened at the neck opening with a zipper; we use hook and eye closure and/or an ornate button that matches the buttons on the Epitrachelion. If you want a zipper, please write your request on this form. Also please indicate whether you would like just the hook and eye closure, or just the ornate button, or both - as the closure at the neck.*

#1. Wrist: Standard measure for wrist (#1 above) is 8". If your wrist is **LESS THAN** 8", record it here _____
